## Greg Prendergast Memorial Foundation Athletic Scholarship

Greg Prendergast Sr. was an extremely accomplished teacher who was respected and loved by everyone who knew him. Greg taught for 20 years at Armada Middle School. He taught mostly math (favoring algebra & geometry) but also science, stock club, life skills and economics to 6th, 7th, and 8th graders. This foundation is honored to be able to continue Greg Prendergast's legacy by supporting students pursue their academic careers. Everyone who knew Greg knew him as someone who could be counted on. Both his friends and his students knew he was someone who would spend as much time as needed talking though any life decisions, big or small.
